

In summary Campbells Bay School under the Orange Setting

Orange setting requires individuals and organisations to make good decisions about the health and well being of everyone. Term two looks very much as close to 'normal' as we have been for some time. With these reduced restrictions, comes great responsibility. Always an **abundance of caution should be taken**. Should transmission rates increase in our community/school, some activities and measures will need tweaking. Term two is about flexible, responsive health measures that make sense for our school and context.

FEELING UNWELL

- Continue to keep your children home from school if they are unwell. Particularly as we know that this winter will bring many strains of cold and flu viruses.
- **Please still inform the school if your child is COVID-19 positive or a household contact. The school *will continue* to alert parents via email of a case that has been in class or multiple cases in their child's class.**

MASK WEARING

- Face masks are **recommended and supported** but no longer required by any staff, student or visitor.
- At times, risk assessments will be made for certain activities that may require students (year 4+) or parents/visitors to wear a mask.

VISITORS ON SITE

- Parents and visitors can enter the school buildings and classes at pick up and drop off times to say hello. We recommended that you wear a mask. Face to face parent meetings with the teacher can resume, with masks.

GATHERINGS

- Some curriculum events may go ahead. Dependent on a risk assessment.
- Gatherings of the whole school will be avoided, particularly as we are heading into winter months.
- Team gatherings will be able to go ahead, such as team assemblies and team sport.

ACTIVITIES

- Students will return to play anywhere at lunchtime (with the usual exception of year grouped playgrounds).
- Collaborative learning across classes, buddy classes, peer mediation, lunchtime activities will all resume.
- All music, choirs and cultural activities can resume.
- Ezlunch orders will resume.
- All extra-curricular after school activities will resume, this includes music lessons.

OTHER

- School gates still open only from 8.30am - this is a health and safety issue as there is no adequate supervision for students arriving before this time. No students should be playing on the playgrounds before school starts (due to no supervision). If you need to drop your child off earlier, please register them for Before School Care with SKIDS in our school hall.
- No vaccination passes are required.

- No scanning is required, the usual visitor register for parents coming on site beyond pick up and drop off times is required.

OTHER HEALTH MEASURES

- Handwashing
- Surface disinfection
- Stay home if unwell
- Keep spaces well ventilated - *In colder weather, ventilation is easier to achieve. This can be achieved by having windows open a little (with heating on) and then refresh the room by opening all doors and windows, during break times. CO2 monitors will continue to measure class ventilation throughout the season's changes.*
