Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Year 0/1 and 2 will begin a new learning journey in term four exploring the concept of 'change'. Our focus for this inquiry will be the science curriculum, particularly the concepts of chemical and physical change. In order to support this learning we will be visiting Ambury Farm in Mangere Bridge, where students will get to see these types of change in a real life context. This trip will be the immersion experience to launch us into our learning for the coming term.

Our trip sessions run over three days (to accommodate all junior classes) during week eight, term three. Please see below as to when your child's class trip will be.

**Tuesday 13 September – Rooms 4, 17, 33 & 36**

**Wednesday 14 September – Rooms 1, 3, 15 & 37**

**Thursday 15 September – Rooms 2, 5, 16 & 35**

All rooms will be departing by bus at approximately 9.05am, and we will be due back by approximately 2.30pm.

Students will need to wear their school uniform, with the exception of footwear. Students must wear **closed toe shoes** for health and safety reasons. Gumboots may also be worn.

The farm trip involves activities both inside and outside. Therefore students must also bring a hat and a raincoat in the event that either is needed.

Please ensure students have morning tea and lunch and that they have a named drink bottle.

Each class requires four or five parents to help supervise on the day (depending on class size). If you are available to accompany your child's class, and you have completed the Police Vetting process, please fill out the request form below **before Friday 12 August** and return this to your child's classroom teacher.

*\*\*Please note that we are limited on the number of helpers we can take on the day, so if you are selected you will receive an email confirming this with further information shortly after Friday 12 August.*
