### **2022 Campbells Bay School WELL-A-thon – Fundraiser**

Like all New Zealand Schools, Campbells Bay School relies on fundraising revenue to further enhance opportunities for our students. This year we are running a 'WELL-A-thon' to both raise funds to assist our school, and also to deepen knowledge of health and wellbeing for our students, staff and whanau. Our students will be seeking sponsorship for their participation in WELL-A-thon activities over the coming weeks.

#### **How will this fundraiser work?**

We are running this in two parts simultaneously. **Part A** - a 'bingo' board of activities for children to enjoy by themselves or with their friends and family. **Part B** - a 'quiz' which is a given set of questions to learn and practice at home over the coming weeks. There will be a quiz test day at school, where children will have a go at answering their ten questions in their classroom.

After the success of last year, we have again partnered with the New Zealand based online fundraising company, Raise It. Raise It specialises in working with New Zealand schools to maximise their fundraising efforts. It is also a great platform for collecting sponsorship online making it super easy for everyone - no more door knocking, your child can collect more donations from further afield (friends and family living overseas, colleagues etc.) and no need to worry about handling all that cash and bringing it into school!

#### **How do I sign my child up to fundraise online?**

The process is simple, sign up for your child's own web page to send out to collect online sponsorship. Sponsorship can be collected from anyone, anywhere and sponsors can choose their own currency to donate in, if they wish. - You will find the 'Set up a student fundraising page' button to click on.
- You will then need to choose your child's area of the school as their fundraising team (Junior School Y0-2, Middle School Y3-4, Senior School Y5-6).
- Then follow the prompts to enter your child's details.

- All student totals update in real time and your sponsors can leave your child messages of encouragement.

#### **Prizes**

We have a range of fundraising prizes available for those students who have an online page. These include spot prizes and overall fundraising prizes for schools/ individuals. #### **What about cash donations?**

If you are unable to create an online fundraising page for your child, cash donations will be accepted on *Thursday 25 August*. Send any donations in a named envelope with your child to school or deliver to your child's teacher. Cash donations will be added to the grand total of monies raised.

#### **What happens on Quiz Testing Week?**

Testing Week will be 15 August - 19 August. Your child's teacher will choose a day and time that best suits their class and will inform you by email of when this day is. Please send in your child's bingo board during this week with its points total to your teacher. When your child has completed the quiz in class, the teacher will combine the total points from part A & B and children will bring their results home in their book bag where you then can celebrate and collect any sponsorship money you need to collect. You have until Friday 26 August to collect all of your child's sponsorship money.

# Timeline for our CBS WELL-A-thon

<b>Launch day:</b> <b>Friday 29 July</b>	Students will have the bingo activities and questions/answers in their book bag and your child's class teacher will email you a link to an online copy. Sign your child up on this link for beginning to collect sponsors <a href="https://campbellsbay.raiseit.co.nz/hub">https://campbellsbay.raiseit.co.nz/hub</a>
<b>Getting sponsors and learning our WELL-A-Thon:</b> <b>29 July - 26 August</b>	Once your child has their fundraiser web page set up, you can share the link and start getting sponsors for your child. Sponsors can make their online donation at any time before 26 August. Students can start learning the answers to the questions that they received and start enjoying the bingo board of activities.
<b>Quiz testing week (in class):</b> <b>15 August - 19 August</b>	Children bring in their bingo board to school on (or before) their quiz test day. The quiz test will be anytime during this week, depending on what is happening in your child's class. The teacher will choose a suitable day. Your child's class teacher will inform you by email when the test will be for their class. The combined total points (from the bingo and quiz) will come home once the teacher has marked it, this will be before 24 August. If your child is away on test day, they will do the test when they come back to school (if it is on or before Monday 22 August).
<b>Collecting money through sponsors:</b> <b>29 July - 26 August</b> <b>*Cash donations Thursday 25 August</b>	Online donations can be made at any time through each child's Raiselt page. All donations must be completed by 26 August.
